To whom it may concern,

This is to certify that, in conformity to 14 CFR 145.53(c), the Mather Aviation , LLC, Domestic Repair Station No. PCPR439B training program requirements established by 14 CFR 145.165(a) and 49 CFR Part 172, Subpart H, may be found in the Mather Aviation Repair Station Manual Section 04-01-00.

Any employee, contractor or subcontractor of Mather Aviation, LLC who makes any decision or takes any action that could affect the safe transportation of hazardous material shall be trained under a Hazardous Materials Training Program conforming to the requirements of 49 CFR Part 172, Subpart H.

In conformity with 14 CFR 145.206, no repair station employee may perform or directly supervise a job function listed in §121.1001 or §135.501 for, or on behalf of the Part 121 or Part 135 operator including loading of items for transport on an aircraft operated by a Part 121 or Part 135 certificate holder unless that person has received training in accordance with that Part 121 or Part 135 operator's FAA approved hazardous materials training program, and that the repair station will acknowledge receipt of the Part 121 or Part 135 operator notification required under §121.1005(e) and §135.505(e) of this chapter prior to performing work for, or on behalf of that certificate holder.
